Class Description: This is an athletic team class. Grading is based on participation.

Expectations: All student athletes must attend each class prepared to train.

Attendance: The Granite District and Skyline High School policies are in full effect in this class.

0-1 Tardies = **4**; 2 Tardies = **3**; 3 Tardies = **2**; 4 Tardies = **1**; 5 or more Tardies = **0**

Grading Procedures: Grades are based on participation. The following percent scale will be used to determine letter grades:

93-100 = A	88-89.9 = B+	80-83.9 = B-	74-77.9 = C	67-69.9 = D+	55-59.9 = D-
90-92.9 = A-	84-87.9 = B	78-79.9 = C+	70-73.9 = C-	60-66.9 = D	0-54.9 = F

Class Participation: Each class period (workout) is worth 20 participation points. Every missing part (5% of workout time) is less a participation point. Skyline Swim Team Class made-ups maybe arranged through communication with Coach Pereira at non-prescribed practice.

The Skyline High School Swim Team has team selections. If you make the team on tryout date, you must remain in good membership standing to remain on the team. Tryouts and the first swimming practice begin on Monday, September 20. The season concludes with the 5A State Swimming Championships on February 11-12.

Mandatory Fees: \$40 – Athletic swim participation (checks to Skyline High School – paid at the bookstore).
\$10 – Building/Class (checks to Skyline High School – paid at the bookstore).
\$10 – Athletic transportation (checks to Skyline High School – paid at the bookstore).
\$160 – Team Equipment (checks to Skyline High School – paid at the bookstore).

Letter “S” awards

1) Participation

1. Complete the season with Skyline Swim Team with Member in Good Standing status (Team Disclosure).

2) Competition or Loyalty & Persistence

A) Competition

1. Any team member placing in the top six (All-Region) in an individual event at the Region Championships.
2. Any team member who qualifies for the state championship in an individual or relay event.

B) Loyalty & Persistence

1. Any senior team member in good standing, who has not earned a letter at the completion of their senior year, may be awarded a letter “S.”
